Adoption of BIM in European legislation

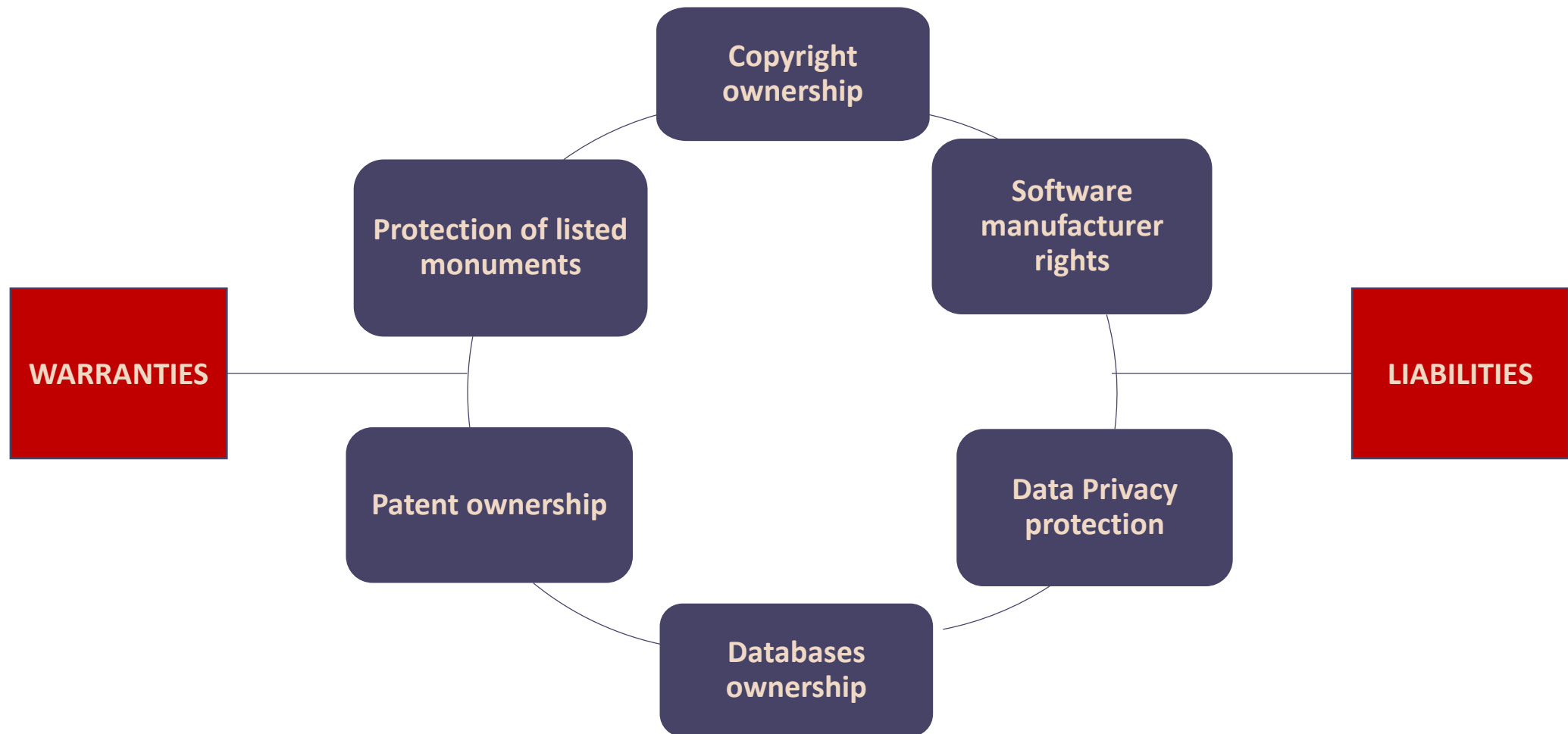
European Directive 2014/24/EU of 26th February 2014 on public procurement and repealing in article 22§4 provide that: *“For public works contracts and design contests, Member States may require the use of specific electronic tools, such as of building information electronic modelling tools or similar.”*

Adoption of BIM in domestic legislations (example France)

Transposition of Directive 2014/24/EU of 26th February 2014 in French law by order n°2015-899 of 23th July 2015. However, this order makes no reference explicitly to BIM.

Decree No. 2016-360 of 25th March 2016 on public procurement: First French act referring explicitly to BIM in Articles 42 III and 42 IV.
